**THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI  
IS NEXT WEEKEND, June 25/26**

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed before the Saturday Vigil Mass at 3pm; Sunday immediately following the 9am Mass up until the 11am Mass; and again on Sunday at 4pm up until the 5pm Mass. Thus, we'll need adorers in Church on June 25th, from 3pm to 4pm; and on June 26th, from 10am to 11am, and 4pm to 5pm. A sign-up sheet is posted in the Adoration Chapel of the Little Shepherds.

*The Adoration Chapel is in need of adorers, particularly on Tuesdays, from 9am to 10am, 11am to Noon and 1pm to 2pm. Please consider committing to an hour a week before the Eucharistic Lord. We will spend all eternity beholding the glorious Face of the Lord. It is not inappropriate to imagine that those who spend their earthly lives beholding His Face, will shine more radiantly as they behold the Face of God forever in Heaven.*

**WHAT MAKES A GREAT CATHOLIC DAD!**

**Keep Holy the Lord's Day...and all those other days (Exodus 20:8):** Fatherhood is the ultimate exercise in getting priorities straight. In too many households, mom is the “keeper of the Faith.” But this cannot be good enough for us. Our kids are watching, and they will do what we do. They're watching if we're ambivalent about getting to Mass.

**Teach your children the Faith (John 20:29):** Faith is learned best by example, and it requires genuine belief. It requires surrender. And the single best way to raise children who have unshakable faith in God is to teach them that there are things they can trust and believe in unconditionally — like their dads.

**Don't forget forgiveness (Matthew 18:21 -22):** Few other traditions require that sinners confess sins aloud. In this way, Catholicism teaches accountability as well as reminding us of God's bottomless well of forgiveness — great lessons to teach our kids... to admit to our children when we are wrong, ask their forgiveness when we mess up, and show them that we and their mothers forgive, and ask forgiveness of, each other all the time. This reminds them that mistakes are allowed. They are fully human and fully expected as part of our faith journey.

**Give and let give (Proverbs 28:27):** “When there's a piano to be moved, don't reach for the stool.” Let your children see you giving, and talk with them about why you give and why giving is important. Let your kids put the envelope in the church collection basket on Sundays. Teach them to be generous!

**Get caught praying (Luke 11:1):** Pray with your children — over meals, at bedtime, when driving in the car. Praying with someone is a pretty intimate act. Start with gratitude for blessings, then pray for people you know and love and who may need help. Finally, get into the nitty gritty “gimmies”: praying for good weather for trips or for strength to do well on a test. Doing so teaches kids that we're all in an ongoing relationship with God and that the conversation requires them to talk as well as to listen.

**Be “Mr. Doesn't Know It All” (Psalm 139:5-7):** Dads often put a lot of pressure on themselves not to get stumped. But questions of faith are common and often come out of the blue such as, “Why do we die?” “What's a soul?” “I don't know” is a legitimate answer, but the real grace comes in what we say next: “Let's look it up together.” Finding answers with our children create lessons that stick.

**“Traditionnn! Tradition!” (1 Cor 11:2):** Ashes on our foreheads. The Hail Mary. Rosaries. Novenas. Holy Water. These “sacramentals” are what make us uniquely Catholic. They give comfort, grow faith, and are very much worth preserving. Passing on these rituals to our children — not just by rote, but by practice— teaches them that being Catholic means that they are part of deep and long-held traditions. And it teaches them that, as Catholics, they will never be alone.
