Who We Will Serve In 2024-2025:

The Sheepfold:

A sheepfold is a walled enclosure created to shelter and protect a flock of sheep against predators and thieves, particularly at night. This is what our **Youth and Family Religious Formation Groups** will also do. We will create spaces for our youth and their families where they can come to find the rest, shelter, and the nourishment they need to live in this world as disciples of Christ without being overcome by discouragement or indifference.

Our Sheepfold:

- 1. Youth Pre-k to 5th grades (Fatima's Little Flock)
- 2. Youth 6th 8th grades (Fatima's LaMS)
- 3. Youth 9th 12th (Fatima's Young Shepherds)
- 4. Adult Men and Women Formation

The prayer is that each year we will add to Our Sheepfold important groups of people that also need to be ministered to such as Married Couples, Young Adult Professionals, Elderly, Parents of Special Need Children, etc.

1. Fatima's Little Flock (Pre-k - 5th grades)

What does "Fatima's Little Flock" do?

The "Fatima's Little Flock" will provide religious formation programs, resources, events, and activities that are designed to engage the youth in our parish and school community in grades Pre-k – 5th.

2024-2025 Religious Formation Program:

Pflaum Gospel Weeklies

The BEST and ONLY alternative to bulky, expensive textbooks, the Pflaum Gospel Weeklies Faith Formation Program combines a complete doctrinal catechesis with the liturgical life of the Church.

The content of the program flows from each Sunday's Gospel, and students learn their faith within the rhythms and seasons of the liturgical year. Every lesson goes home to involve parents (who hear the same Gospel on Sunday) making it easier for them to discuss topics with their children. The children gather for prayer, song, and an activity that taps into something they already know or have experienced and introduces the Sunday Gospel theme. They proclaim the Gospel together and then learn the related Church teaching and doctrine. Games, discussion questions, and activities reinforce the Scripture, doctrine, and life application.

This program will allow for children be more engaged in the mass because of what they learned at Gospel Weeklies. Thus, allowing their parents to enter into Mass more fully themselves. Gospel Weeklies involves the entire family and gives parents agency to bring their children up in the faith and in our Church each weekend at Our Lady of Fatima.

Meetings:

Meetings will be held once a month, for the first year, from 10am–11am, giving the youth and their families the chance to go to the 9am or 11am mass.

In between meetings, we will provide families with lessons to do together at home. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that "parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children;" and "through the grace of the sacrament of marriage, parents receive the responsibility and privilege of evangelizing their children."

Of course, if you were not a member of the parish when we started you can join later in the year if you can commit. A Core Team Member MUST be Safe Environment trained, always follow diocesan rules for Safe Environment, and be up to date on Virtus training.

Fatima's Little Flock Core Team Positions for the 2024-2025 School Year:

Welcoming Leader (2-4 adults) – Welcoming Leader will welcome children at each meeting as they come through the doors and sign them in by distributing name tags. The Welcoming Leader will also collect name tags and sign out children at the end of the meeting. Can also serve as a Co-Catechist Leader.

The "Fatima's LaMS" will provide religious formation programs, resources, events, and activities that are designed to engage the youth in our parish and school community in grades $6^{th} - 8^{th}$.

2024-2025 Religious Formation Program:

YDisciple

YDisciple helps parishes empower volunteers and parents by training them to launch small groups and engage teens. YDisciple couples video resources with extensive training and support for leaders. YDisciple includes the highest caliber videos for young people but also leader guides to help adults facilitate meaningful discussion, participant guides to help teens grasp key concepts, and parent resources to encourage parents to stay engaged.

Why small groups? In a small group a teen can feel known, loved, and cared for. *Teens need to belong in order to believe*. A level of confidentiality can be achieved which gives teens the freedom to open up about their struggles and doubts. In a small group, there is the greater chance to catch things teens don't understand and discuss. In addition, the small group allows the leader to know their disciples well and thus be able to customize the topics of discussion that best reach those teens.

Welcoming Leader (2-3 adults) – Welcoming Leader will welcome youth at each meeting as they come through the doors and sign them in by distributing name tags. The Welcoming Leader will also collect name tags and sign out children at the end of the meeting.

Emcee Leader (2 men and 2 women) - As an Emcee Leader, you will rotate with the other Emcee Leaders to be the one who opens and closes meetings with prayer, reading reflections, playing videos, asking large group discussion questions, transitioning youth and small group leaders in and out of small groups, and keeping track of time for small group leaders. You will be sent the session details in advance so you can successfully lead the youth through the night's activities.

Snack Leader (2 - 4 adults) - Will oversee contacting and reminding volunteers who signed up to bring snacks. Emcee Leader (2 men and 2 women) - As an Emcee Leader, you will rotate with the other Emcee Leaders to be the one who opens and closes meetings with prayer, reading reflections, playing videos, asking large group discussion questions, transitioning youth and small group leaders in and out of small groups, and keeping track of time for small group leaders. You will be sent the session details in advance so you can successfully lead the youth through the night's activities.

Snack Leader (2 - 4 adults) - Will oversee contacting and reminding volunteers who signed up to bring snacks. You will be provided with the contact list and calendar so that you know who signed up for what dates to provide snacks. You will provide volunteers with important details such as what time snacks should be dropped off and the quantity needed. Snack Leaders will also set up, distribute, and clean up snack areas before and after each meeting.

Girls Small Group Leader (6 – 12 women) - Each small group of youth will have two adult leaders that will facilitate the small group discussions. Don't worry! All small group discussion questions will be provided. <u>Small Group Leaders must attend the mandatory small group leader training session!</u> At this training session you will be equipped with tools needed to be a GREAT small group leader.

Boys Small Group Leader (6 – 12 men) - Each small group of youth will have two adult leaders that will facilitate small group discussions. Don't worry! All small group discussion questions will be provided. *Small Group Leaders must attend the mandatory small group leader training session!* At this training session you will be equipped with tools needed to be a GREAT small group leader.
